

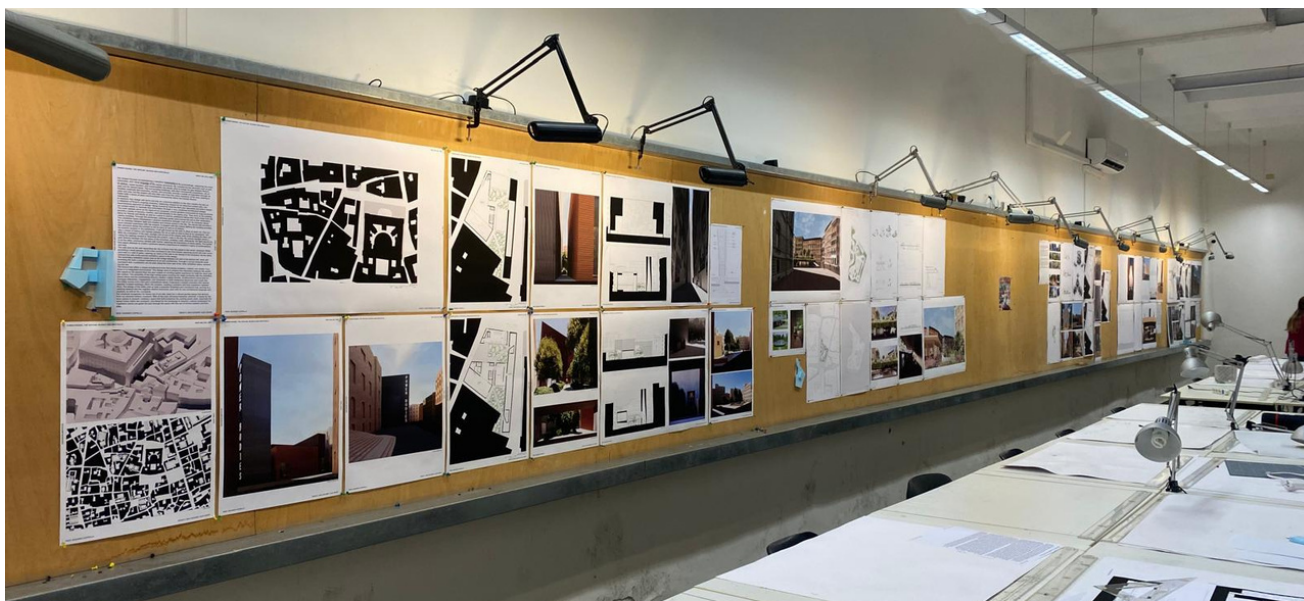

It's the end of the semester!

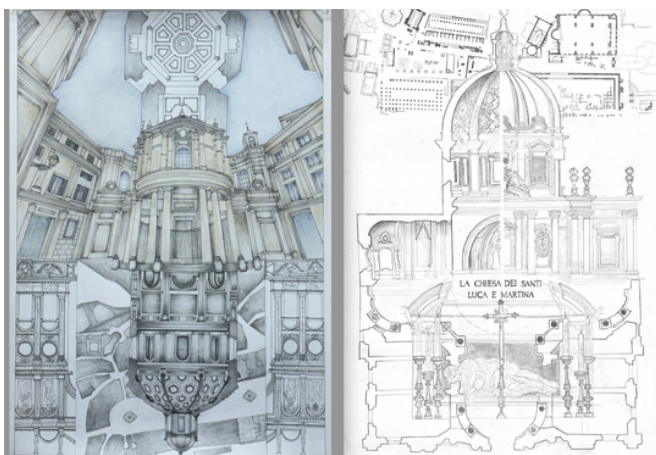

Start of the Jubilee Year

On December 24, 2024, the Jubilee Year kicks off. This year of holy sacrament comes has been periodically convoked by the Pope since 1300.
