Visiting the Vittoriano with Jeremy and Isaac



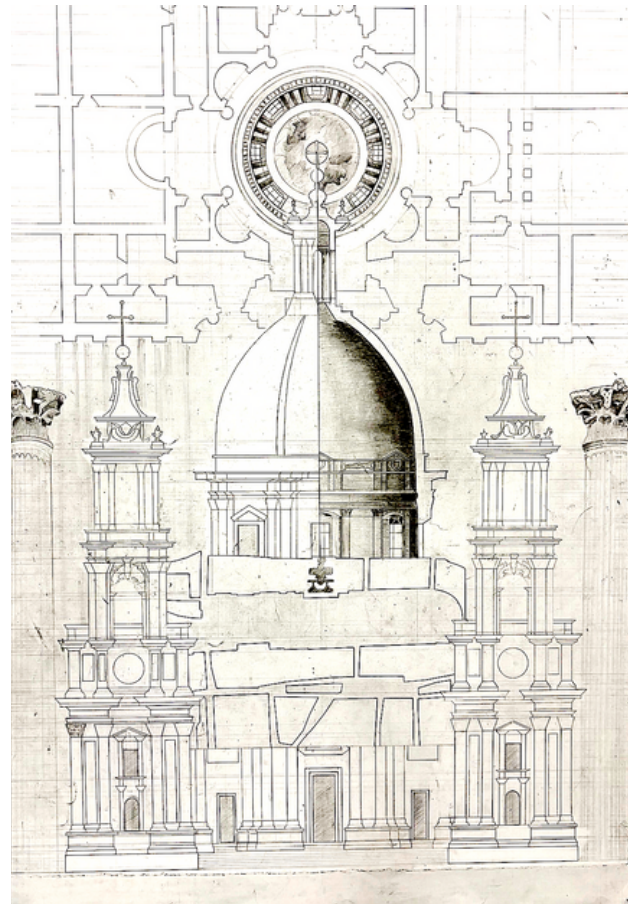
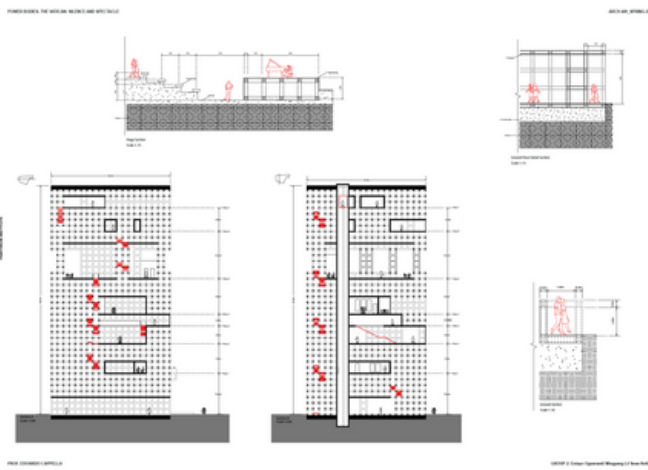

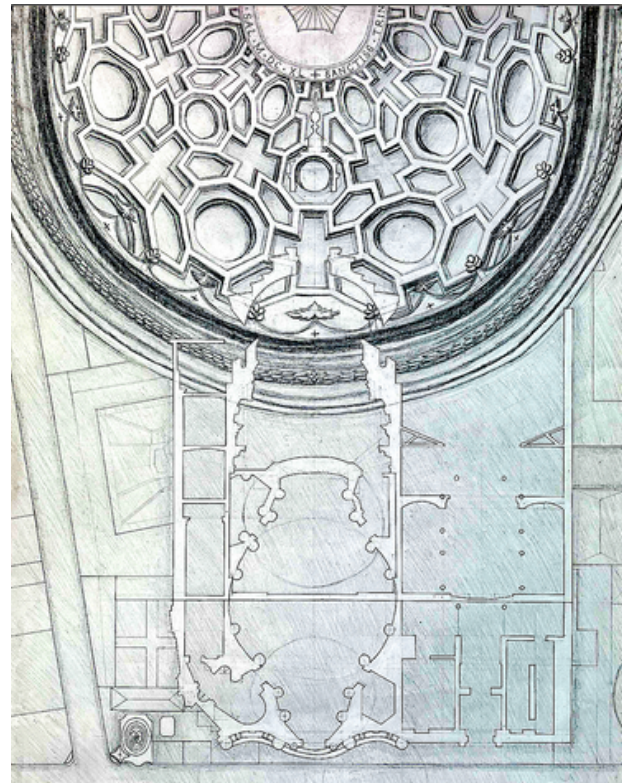
